

## **ADMISSION OF NEW STUDENTS**

Unesa new student admission is carried out by following the rules set by the Ministry of Education and Culture as well as internal regulations of Unesa. The admission of new students is made through various selection paths at both the national and university level.

### **1. Admission of New Students through SNMPTN**

SNMPTN is a pathway for new student admissions that are held nationally for S-1 Study Programs through the selection of academic achievements at the school level (SMA / MA / SMK / MAK).

### **2. Admission of New Students through SBMPTN**

The SBMPTN is a pathway for accepting new students for undergraduate programs, which are carried out jointly with other state universities through computer-based written tests, as well as skills tests for arts and sports study programs.

### **3. Acceptance of New Students through the SPMB Path**

The independent pathway is an admission of undergraduate students and applied undergraduate (D-IV) levels whose mechanisms are regulated by Unesa. The independent path consists of:

- a. regular track;
- b. the path of achievement consisting of religious achievements, sports achievements, artistic achievements, and achievements of persons with disabilities;
- c. applied undergraduate pathway.
